

2018 SPRING TOUR

HOW TO PACK

Pack so that you can lift and carry everything in one trip.

Make sure your name is on all of your personal items.

So many things look alike, it is easy to get them mixed up on the bus.

UNIFORM BACK PACK/CINCH SACK

Pack your complete chorus uniform, including pants, polo shirt, shoes and stockings or socks.

You may want to keep your shoes in a separate plastic bag and then that bag is placed in your back pack. There will be occasions where we will stop and change into uniforms without unloading suitcases from the bus!

Do not pack any additional items in this bag!

“FLUFF BAG”

Pack a carry-on bag (backpack) that will fit into the overhead compartment of the bus (approximately 12”W x 18”D x 10”H) with personal items including grooming items (make-up, combs, brushes, toothbrushes, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.). This should stay with you rather than being packed in your suitcases. We will on some occasions be going from the bus into uniforms before luggage is unloaded. You will want to “freshen up” when you change.

ONE SUITCASE – STANDARD LARGE OR SMALLER

Pack appropriate clothing for the activities scheduled during the week. Look over the itinerary to help you decide what to pack.

A word about clothes...

EVERYONE is expected to dress modestly at all times. Tight clothes, such as leggings and yoga pants, revealing low cut blouses, and short shorts that have an inseam less than 5 inches, are not considered appropriate.

Please expect to be asked to change if you are wearing such clothing—better yet—don’t bring any along!

You will have some opportunities to wash clothes on tour. You may even ask your host’s at your host home if you could wash some clothes. If you do ask a host to allow you to wash clothes at their home please be considerate of the hour and the amount of clothes you are asking to get washed.

Other items you may want to bring:

Bible, camera or small pillow.

You may bring a personal listening device (MP3 player, phone, etc...) and your favorite appropriate music. Personal DVD players are not to be brought on tour. We will watch appropriate movies as we travel on the bus.

SWIMSUIT

Discretion is urged in your choice of swimsuit. For the girls please only bring 1 piece or tankini that meets in the middle. Any person that is judged by the chaperones to be immodestly dressed will be asked to change or cover up. There will be a swimming pool at the Comfort Suites Hotel in Washington DC.

DO NOT BRING

Tobacco, Vapes, alcohol, drugs, or weapons.

We ask that you not bring magazines or DVD’s that could offend others.
